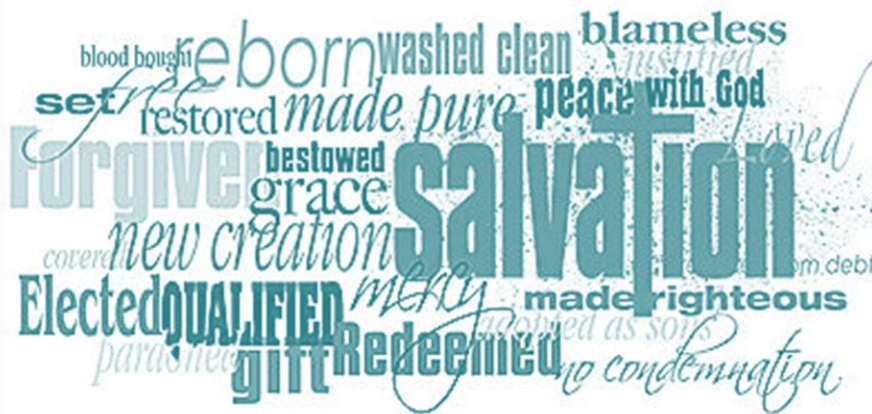

God's Word – Our Spiritual Mirror

James 1:22-25 But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; or he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.

These verses tell us that the WORD, the Bible, and specifically, the “law of liberty” which is the New Covenant, is a mirror of who we are in Christ. We must view our identity through this spiritual mirror! The Word of God is a mirror to what is already a reality in our born-again spirit. But it won't impact you until you see it; until it becomes real to you.

What do you see?

Faith is the *revelation* of the will of God in the heart of man that produces certainty, conviction and action. (Barry Bennett)

When you have “revelation,” you not only believe with your mind, but it becomes *real* to you in your heart. It becomes your new identity. You will see yourself through the lens of God's Word.

What's real to you?

Vision of the heart is a harvest of the words we have heard and believed. We are either giving place to words of fear and limitations or we are giving place to God's promises. (Barry Bennett) What does the Bible say about who God is? What does it say about His nature and His will concerning you?

John 14:7 “If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him.”

Jesus is the perfect representation of the nature and will of God. We only need to look to Him to know God.

The Apostle Paul said:

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ. (Ephesians 1:3)

And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:19)

Jesus said, “Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the kingdom. (Luke 12:32)

Getting our needs met and living in the reality of our spiritual identity is a matter of believing what we can’t see or feel in the natural, but seeing with our spiritual eyes.

Because it's God's Word, the Bible is like a mirror where you can see who we truly are in our reborn spirit. As you spend time in scripture, you learn what God says about you, and your new identity in Christ. As you learn these new things about yourself, you will find you start to behave differently, because what you do flows out of who you think you are.

You become a doer of the word. That's when you will begin to see the victories God has promised you.

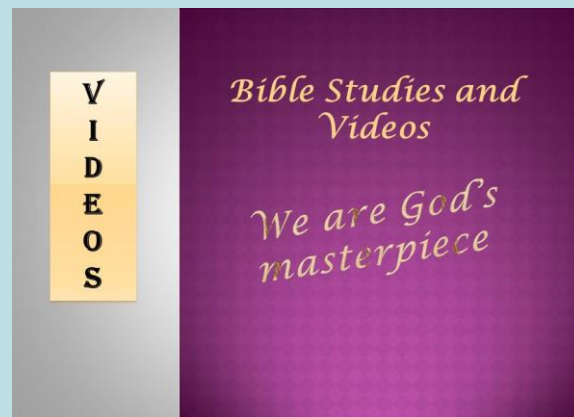

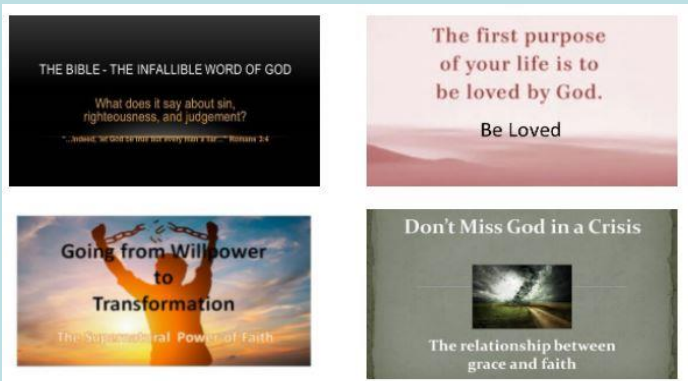

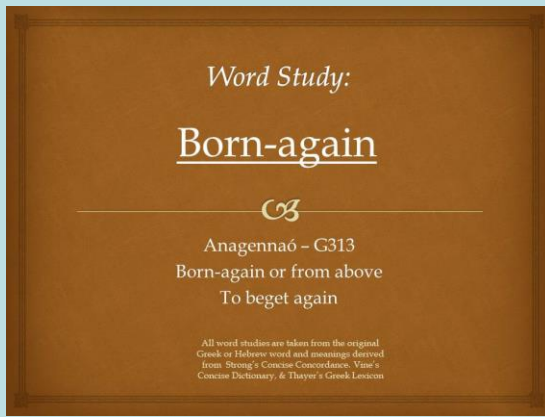

Featured Testimony - Healing of a Cyst by Kristine Repino

Several years ago, I began experiencing a sore on my backside near my tailbone. At times it would get so tender I couldn't sit or lay down without it hurting for days. I had recently lost a lot of weight, and so I assumed this was probably caused by that, and aggravated by exercising or sitting for prolonged period of times. But this went on for several years without any topical relief from various over the counter options. The cyst would become painfully swollen, and ooze/bleed so often, I was adjusting my days because I couldn't do some of the normal stuff whenever it was irritated. I finally went to the doctor, and she confirmed there was an infection causing the cyst. She talked about the likelihood of having to get it surgically removed. Even though it was good to finally know this was something that could be taken care of, and according to my doctor needed to be, I wasn't too keen on having to have a surgery to remove it.

My husband encouraged me that it is good we now know what the problem is, and he spoke healing to this cyst, infection, and declared that I would NOT need surgery! Over the next couple weeks, I realized I wasn't having any swelling or soreness and that the cyst was not visually obvious any more. That week, I was scheduled to meet with the doctor who would do the surgery; and when he examined me, he said, "I don't see anything, there's nothing here." My husband said, "That was the fastest doctor's appointment we've ever been too! Praise God!" Infected cyst GONE for good! It doesn't matter how big or small the problem is, Jesus is our healer.

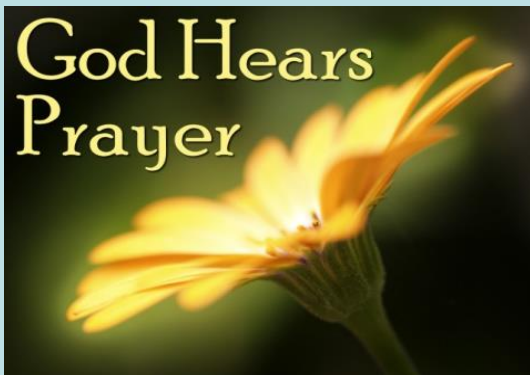

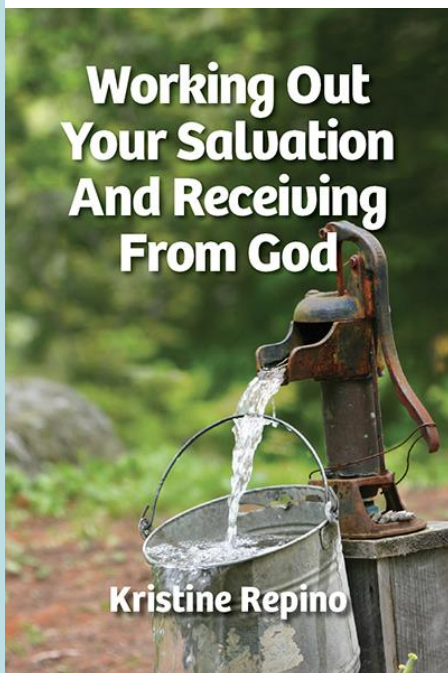
